An Order to: Lay Out and Accept Point Shore Drive and Point Shore Overlook as Public Ways

Summary: The City Council shall lay out and accept Point Shore Drive and Point Shore Overlook as public ways.


Be it Ordered by the City Council of the City of Amesbury assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:

The City Council of the City of Amesbury, acting pursuant to G.L. c. 82, §§21 - 24, having deemed that common convenience and necessity require the layout as public ways of Point Shore Drive and Point Shore Overlook, hereby lays out and accepts Point Shore Drive and Point Shore Overlook as public ways, all as shown on a plan entitled "Street Acceptance Plan Point Shore Meadows Prepared for Amanda Lane Realty Trust," dated September 21, 2023, prepared by Ranger Engineering Group, Inc., which plan was referred to the Planning Board and which plan is hereby adopted as a part of this Order, and all land lying within the layout of Point Shore Drive and Point Shore Overlook is hereby laid out and accepted as public ways; and further votes to accept four drainage easements located upon "Open Space Parcel A," "Open Space Parcel B," Lots 5 and 6, and Lots 11 and 12, all as shown on the aforementioned plan; and further votes to authorize the Mayor to sign the plan on behalf of the City Council and to accept a deed of such land and easements on such terms and conditions as she shall deem appropriate, and to execute all documents and take all related actions necessary or appropriate to effectuate the foregoing layout, acceptance and land acquisition.

The aforementioned plan is hereby forwarded to the City Clerk for filing.

Councilor Steven Stanganelli moved to approve Bill 2023-111. He was seconded by Councilor Michael Hogg. A roll call vote was taken, and the motion passed 7-1, President Nicholas Wheeler opposed. (Councilor Adrienne Lennon absent)


