**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE
CITY OF AMERY**

The Common Council of the City of Amery, Polk County, Wisconsin do ordain as follows:

§ 14-15. Public Safety Committee.

- A. Membership.** The Public Safety Committee shall consist of (3) Alderpersons from the Amery City Council. The members of the committee are to be appointed by the Mayor as applicable and subject to the approval of the Common Council.
- B. Duties.** The committee shall undertake such tasks as directed by the Common Council and generally shall provide oversight on police issues. The Committee shall be specifically responsible for oversight of the following issues:
- 1) To make recommendations to the City Administrator and Mayor or other pertinent committees or boards regarding matters of police issues and public safety.
 - 2) To periodically review and advise the council on ordinances and policy revisions related to licensing, permitting, public offenses and nuisances and matters of public safety of this code, and make recommendations for appropriate additions or changes.
 - 3) To supervise the regulation of traffic and parking.
 - 4) To recommend to council the approval of special event permits.
 - 5) Union Contract negotiations.
- C. Term.** The term will be two (2) years and members will be determined at the Organizational Meeting held each year in April. The City Administrator and Police Chief shall participate in the Committee as advisors.
