GENERAL BYLAW ARTICLE XII SECTION 48.5 AMENDED

General Bylaw Article XII Section 48 amended subsection 5(G) by amending the table to expand the permitted revenue sources and expenses from the Division of Recreation, Division of Youth Services, Division of Elder Services, and Compost Program revolving funds as follows: (additional language underscored):

Authorized Revolving Funds. The table establishes:

- A. Each revolving fund authorized for use by a Town department, board, committee, agency or officer;
- B. The department or agency head, board, committee or officer authorized to spend from each fund;
- C. The fees, charges and other monies charged and received by the department, board, committee, agency or officer in connection with the program or activity for which the fund is established that shall be credited to each fund by the town accountant;
- D. The expenses of the program or activity for which each fund may be used;
- E. Any restrictions or conditions on expenditures from each fund;
- F. Any reporting or other requirements that apply to each fund; and
- G. The fiscal years each fund shall operate under this bylaw.
