

**CITY OF ASBURY PARK
BOND ORDINANCE NUMBER 2024-12**

**CAPITAL ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR ROOF
REPLACEMENT AND APPROPRIATING \$2,005,308.87
THEREFOR, AUTHORIZED IN AND BY THE CITY OF
ASBURY PARK, IN THE COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, NEW
JERSEY**

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Asbury Park, in the County of Monmouth, New Jersey (the “City”) has determined to provide for roof replacement for various City buildings; and

WHEREAS, the City has available \$100,000.00 in the City’s General Capital Surplus; and

WHEREAS, the City expects to receive \$1,531,906.13 in grant funds from the American Rescue Plan and \$373,402.74 in grant funds from the New Jersey Social Services Building Replacement Grant Program to partially fund said project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ASBURY PARK, IN THE COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The improvements described in Section 2 of this ordinance are hereby authorized as general improvements to be undertaken in and by the City. For the improvements or purposes described in Section 2, there is hereby appropriated \$2,005,308.87, said sum being inclusive of \$100,000.00 from the City’s General Capital Surplus and \$1,531,906.13 grant funds expected to be received from the American Rescue Plan for roof replacement for the Municipal Building and the Public Works Building, and \$373,402.74 grant funds expected to be received from the New Jersey Social Services Building Replacement Grant Program for roof replacement for the Transportation Center.

Section 2. The improvements hereby authorized to be undertaken consist of roof replacement for various City buildings, including the Municipal Building, Public Works Building and Transportation Center, together with all purposes necessary, incidental or appurtenant thereto, all as shown on and in accordance with contracts, plans, specifications or requisitions therefor on file with or through the City Clerk, as finally approved by the governing body of the City.

Section 3. The 2024 capital budget of the City will conform to the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency herewith. The resolution in the form promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full detail of the amended capital budget and capital program as approved by the Director of the Division of Local Government Services is on file with the City Clerk and is available there for public inspection.

Section 4. An aggregate amount not exceeding \$100,000.00 for engineering costs, legal fees and other items of expense listed in and permitted under N.J.S.A. 40A:2-20 is included as part of the cost of said improvements and is included in the estimated cost indicated herein for said improvements.

Section 5. Any grant or similar moneys from time to time received by the City for the improvements or purposes described in Section 2 hereof, shall be applied to direct payment of the cost of the improvements within the appropriation herein authorized.

Section 6. The City Attorney and other City officials and representatives are hereby authorized to do all things necessary to accomplish the purposes of the appropriation made herein.

Section 7. This ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
