**2025 TRANSPORTATION UPDATE ORDINANCE**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Asbury Park (the “City”) has previously established certain traffic regulations concerning metered and permit parking within the City; and

**WHEREAS**, the previous regulations as referenced above shall be collectively referenced herein as the “prior traffic regulations”; and

**WHEREAS**, since adoption of the prior regulations, the parking conditions have been evaluated by the City’s Parking Committee on a continuous basis; and

**WHEREAS**, the Parking Committee has proposed certain new regulations which are set forth in the attached Exhibit A; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Council support the proposed new regulations; and

**WHEREAS**, it is the intention of the Mayor and Council that the revisions set forth in Exhibit A shall amend and supplement the Traffic Control Regulations contained within Chapter VII, entitled “Traffic,” of the “Code of the City of Asbury Park, New Jersey,” accordingly.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED**, by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Asbury Park, in the County of Monmouth and State of New Jersey, that the amended parking regulations as set forth in Exhibit A attached hereto are hereby approved and adopted for use within the City of Asbury Park, and that Chapter VII, entitled “Traffic,” of the “Code of the City of Asbury Park, New Jersey,” is hereby amended and supplemented accordingly.

No person shall park a vehicle at any time upon any streets or parts thereof described, except where other parking regulations have been provided for.

**§ 7-37.1Regulation for the Movement and the Parking of Traffic on Municipal Property and Board of Education Property.**

In accordance with the provisions of N.J.S.A. 39:4-197, the following Municipal and Board of Education property shall have the movement of traffic controlled by the type of regulation indicated. No person shall operate or park a vehicle in violation of the regulations indicated.

**a.** Municipal Complex (City Hall) Parking Lot. The following spaces are located within the municipal complex (City Hall) parking lot located at One Municipal Plaza (Block 2401, Lot 1), and shall be reserved during the hours of 8:00 a.m. through 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, as indicated below.

One parking space - Reserved for City Manager

One parking space – Reserved for Deputy City Manager

One parking space - Reserved for Mayor

One parking space - Reserved for Deputy Mayor

One parking space - Reserved for Councilperson

One parking space- Reserved for Councilperson

One parking space - Reserved for Councilperson

15 Reserved Parking Spaces for City Vehicles

78 Reserved Parking Spaces for City Business Only, subject to the time limitations set forth in Section 7-11.1. All other vehicles will be towed.

**§ 7-23FOUR-WAY STOPS.**
