

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF AURORA, MISSOURI DECLARING RESULTS OF THE MUNICIPAL GENERAL ELECTION HELD IN THE CITY OF AURORA, MISSOURI, ON APRIL 2, 2024

WHEREAS, the City of Aurora, Missouri (the "City"), is a city of the third class and political subdivision of the State of Missouri, duly created, organized and existing under and by virtue of the constitution and laws of the State of Missouri; and

WHEREAS, on Tuesday, April 2, 2024, a General Election was held in the City of Aurora of Lawrence County, State of Missouri for the election of two (2) City Council seats for three - year terms; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to RSMo section 77.380 of the Missouri State Statues reads as follows; all officers elected to offices or appointed to fill a vacancy in any elective office under the city government shall be voters under the laws and constitution of this state and, except appointed officers, must be residents of the city. No person shall be elected or appointed to any office that shall at the time be delinquent in the payment of any state income taxes, personal property taxes, municipal taxes, or real property taxes on the place of residence pursuant to RSMo 115.306.

NOW ,THEREFORE, BE IT, ORDAINED, BY THE CITY COUNCIL AND FOR THE CITY OF AURORA, MISSOURI, as follows:

SECTION I: That it is hereby found and determined that the vote at the Municipal General Election held in the City of Aurora, Lawrence County, State of Missouri on Tuesday, April 2, 2024, for the election of two (2) City Council seats for three-year terms are as follows;

Three Year Term
Vote for Two

Ethan Flood	129
Tony Kennedy	269

SECTION II: Therefore, let it be known that by virtue of receiving the highest number of votes, Joshua Blades and Tony Kennedy are hereby elected to a three-year term of office upon being duly sworn in.

SECTION III: That it is hereby found and determined that notice of the said General Election was duly given and published in the manner provided by law, and that said election was held and conducted in all respects in conformity with the Constitution and laws of the State of Missouri

covering elections in cities of the Third Class, and in accordance with ordinances duly adopted by the City Council.

SECTION IV: That it is hereby found and determined that all citizens filed for the election of City Council members have all complied with RSMo section 77.380, and in accordance with ordinances duly adopted by the City Council and verified by the City Clerk before the said General Election.

SECTION V: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon passage and approval by the Aurora City Council.
