Local Law 2 of the Year 2019

Incorporated Village of Bayville, County of Nassau

A local law to amend the limited time parking from Ludlam Avenue to Pine Park Avenue on the north and south sides of Bayville Avenue, and to establish no stopping or standing of vehicles thirty (30) feet from the east and west corners of Bayville Avenue and Seventeenth Street, on the south side of Bayville Avenue.

BE IT ENACTED by the Board of Trustees of the Incorporated Village of Bayville as follows:

Section 1. This local law is enacted pursuant to the authority contained in the Village Law of the State of New York, the Vehicle and Traffic Law of the State of New York and in Article 2 of the Municipal Home Rule Law of the State of New York.

Section 2. This local law shall be known as Local Law 2019-2, **“A Local Law to Amend Limited Time Parking and Establish No Stopping or Standing on Portions of Bayville Avenue.”**

Section 3. The following street, side, hours, and location are hereby added to Section 75-44 of the Village Code of the Incorporated Village of Bayville, Schedule XI: No Stopping or Standing:

Name of Street	Side	Hours	Location
Bayville Avenue	South	Anytime	From a point 30 feet east of Seventeenth Street to a point 30 feet west of Seventeenth Street

Section 4. The following amendments are hereby made to Section 75-46 of the Village Code of the Incorporated Village of Bayville, Schedule XIII: Limited Time Parking:

Name of Street	Side	Hours	Location
Bayville Avenue	Both	45 min., 6:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.	From Ludlam Avenue to Pine Park Avenue
Bayville Avenue	Both	120 min., 4:00 p.m. to 11:00 p.m.	From Ludlam Avenue to Pine Park Avenue
