OFFICIAL BOROUGH OF BADEN ORDINANCE NO. 972

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF BADEN, COUNTY OF BEAVER AND COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES SECTION 180-3 AND 180-54

WHEREAS, the Baden Borough Council has determined that it would be responsible to update the current parking ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDAINED as follows:

1. Section 180-3 is amended to delete the present language and to substitute the following:

§ 180-3 General parking restrictions.

- A. Except when necessary to avoid conflict with other traffic or to protect the safety of any person or vehicle or in compliance with law or the directions of a police officer or official traffic control device, no person shall:
 - (1) Stand or park a vehicle in the Borough of Baden:
 - (a) within 3 feet of either side of any entrance or exit or public or private driveway.
 - (b) Within 15 feet of a fire hydrant.
 - (c) At any place where official signs prohibit such.
 - (d) On any portion of a public roadway where the curb is painted yellow.
 - (e) With wheels more than 12 inches from the curb.
 - (f) At any place where official signs indicate a loading zone.
 - (g) In the wrong direction on a one-way street.
 - (2) Stop, stand, or park a vehicle:
 - (a) Within an intersection.
 - (b) On a crosswalk.
 - (c) On a sidewalk.
 - (3) Park or leave unattended a vehicle on private property without the consent of the owner or other person in control or possession of the property, except in the case of emergency or disablement of the vehicle.
- **B.** The provisions of the Vehicle Code at 75 Pa.C.S.A. § 3353(a) through (e) are incorporated herein by reference, made part hereof and merged herein as though more fully set forth at length.
- C. Any person violating any provision of Subsections A and B above is guilty of a summary offense and shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of not less than \$25 and not more than \$300, plus costs of prosecution.

2. Section 180-54 is amended to delete the present language and to substitute the following:

§ 180-54 Violations and penalties.

- A. Violations generally. Unless another penalty is expressly provided by the Pennsylvania Vehicle Code (75 Pa.C.S.A. § 101 et seq.) or except as hereinafter specified, every person convicted of a violation of a provision of this chapter, or any supplement thereto, shall be liable to a penalty of not less than \$25 and not more than \$300, plus costs of prosecution.
- B. The peace officer making such report shall also attach to every such vehicle a notice that such vehicle was parked in violation of this article, which notice shall contain instructions to the owner or operator of such vehicle that if he/she shall report to the office of the Chief of Police and pay, for the use of the Borough, the sum of \$25 within five days after the time of such notice, the same shall save such violator from prosecution and payment of the fine and costs hereinabove prescribed, except the following:
 - (1) Section 180-3 A(1)(a), (b), (g) and (2)(b): penalty of \$50; and
 - (2) Section 180-3 B: penalty of \$100 for violation of a reservation for handicap parking.
- 3. That the within Ordinance shall take full force and affect upon passage and approval of same.
