An Amendment to the Boards, Committees and Commissions Ordinance to correct inconsistencies.

The Town of Bar Harbor hereby ordains that Chapter 31, Boards, Committees, and Commissions, of the Town Code is amended as follows:

Chapter 31: Boards, Committees and Commissions

Article IV
Communication and Technologies Committee

§ 31-50 Membership.

This committee has five members. Town staff (the Finance Director and/or the Technical Systems Administrator or their designees) will be nonvoting members and act as advisors. Members need not be Bar Harbor residents.

§ 31-56 Quorum and voting.

A simple majority of voting members is necessary to call a meeting to order as well as take a vote.

Article VIII
Parks and Recreation Committee

§ 31-110 Membership.

This Committee has five members, with one representative from the YMCA, and one of whom may be a Town Councilor who is familiar with the Town's parks and related recreational activities. All members must be Bar Harbor residents, except the YMCA representative, who may or may not be a resident. ~~All members are voting members.~~

§ 31-116 Quorum and voting.

A simple majority of ~~appointed~~ voting members is necessary to call a meeting to order as well as take a vote.
