**ORDINANCE #2026- 741**  
**(Duly Adopted February 9, 2026)**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 625-34.G.(1) OF THE  
BOROUGH OF BATH CODE OF ORDINANCES BY REMOVING 518  
PENN STREET FROM THE LIST OF DESIGNATED HANDICAPPED  
PARKING SPACES**

WHEREAS, a handicapped parking space was previously required at 518 Penn Street in the Borough of Bath; and

WHEREAS, no individuals currently residing at the above-referenced location require a handicapped parking space.

NOW, THEREFORE, upon consideration of the evidence presented at the public hearing, Bath Borough Council hereby enacts and ordains as follows:

**ARTICLE I.**

Chapter 625, Article V, Section 625-34, Handicapped Parking, Subsection G(1) of the Bath Borough Code of Ordinances is hereby amended by removing 518 Penn Street from the list of designated handicapped parking spaces. 518 Penn Street shall be removed from Section 625-34.G(1) of the Bath Borough Code of Ordinances and will no longer have a designated handicapped parking space on the South side of the street.

**ARTICLE II.**

The proper authorities of the Borough are directed to remove any existing handicapped parking signage at the above-referenced location.

**ARTICLE III.**

All ordinances or parts of ordinances that are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

**ARTICLE IV.**

If any section, paragraph, sub-section, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be declared invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of this Ordinance as a whole or any part thereof other than that portion specifically declared invalid.

**ARTICLE V.**


This Ordinance shall become effective on the earliest date permitted by law after its adoption.


