ORDINANCE NO. 2026- 742

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 625-21, 625-22,
625-30, 625-32, AND 625-38 OF THE BATH BOROUGH
CODE OF ORDINANCES BY PROHIBITING CERTAIN
CLASSES, SIZES, AND TYPES OF VEHICLES AND
PROHIBITING PARKING AND STOPPING ON BARRALL
AVENUE**

WHEREAS, the Borough Council of the Borough of Bath has determined that it is appropriate and desirable to prohibit parking and stopping on both sides of Barrall Avenue at all times; and,

WHEREAS, the Borough Council of the Borough of Bath has also determined that it is appropriate and desirable to prohibit certain classes, sizes, and types of vehicles from being operated on Barrall Avenue.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Bath as follows:

ARTICLE I.

Chapter 625, Vehicles and Traffic, Article IV, Additional Specific Regulations, Section 625-21 of the Code of Ordinances of Bath Borough is hereby amended by prohibiting any vehicle or tractor, except passenger vehicles, from being operated upon Barrall Avenue and adding Barrall Avenue to the list of highways with such a restriction in Section 625-21.A as follows:

§625-21.A.

ARTICLE II.

Chapter 625, Vehicles and Traffic, Article IV, Additional Specific Regulations, Section 625-22 of the Code of Ordinances of Bath Borough is hereby amended by prohibiting the operation of any vehicle or other tractor, trailer, or tractor-trailer combination having a gross weight in excess of 8,000 pounds on Barrall Avenue. In particular, Section 625-22.A of the Code of Ordinances of Bath Borough is hereby amended by adding Barrall Avenue to the list of streets with weight restrictions in Section 625-22.A as follows:

ARTICLE III.

Chapter 625, Vehicles and Traffic, Article V, Additional Parking Regulations, Section 625-30 of the Code of Ordinances of Bath Borough is hereby amended by prohibiting parking along Barrall Avenue at all times for all vehicles and adding Barrall Avenue to the list of streets in Section 625-30 as follows:

§625-30.

Barrall Avenue	Both	Entire length

ARTICLE IV.

Chapter 625, Vehicles and Traffic, Article V, Additional Parking Regulations, Section 625-32 of the Code of Ordinances of Bath Borough is hereby amended by removing Barrall Avenue from the list of streets in Section 625-32.

ARTICLE V.

Chapter 625, Vehicles and Traffic, Article V, Additional Parking Regulations, Section 625-38 of the Code of Ordinances of Bath Borough is hereby amended by prohibiting stopping along Barrall Avenue and adding the following restriction to Section 625-38:

§625-38.

Barrall Avenue	Both	Entire Length

ARTICLE VI.

The proper authorities of the Borough are authorized and directed to erect the appropriate traffic and parking restrictions and information signs and/or markings relating to the regulations established by this Ordinance, and to do so in conformity with the provisions of the Pennsylvania Vehicle Code.

ARTICLE VII. **Repealer.**

All ordinances or parts of ordinances that are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

ARTICLE VIII. **Severability.**

If any section, paragraph, sub-section, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be declared invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not


affect the validity of this Ordinance as a whole or any part thereof other than that portion specifically declared invalid.

ARTICLE IX. **Effective Date.**


This Ordinance shall become effective on the earliest date permitted by law after its adoption.




