

ORDINANCE 2026-11

**ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF BEACHWOOD, COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AMENDING CHAPTER 7A
TRAFFIC SCHEDULES BY ADDING CHAPTER 7A-1.1 PARKING BY RESIDENT PERMIT ONLY IN DESIGNATED AREAS OF THE 100
BLOCK OF ANCHOR AVENUE**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Beachwood, County of Ocean, and State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 7A-1 is hereby amended by adding the following language:

Chapter 7A-1.1: RESIDENT PARKING BY PERMIT

7A-1.2 Purpose.

The purpose of this section is to implement a parking permit system to reduce traffic conditions resulting from commercial deliveries to adjacent business. This will protect the streets and their inhabitants from excessive noise and unreasonable burdens in gaining access to their residences.

7A-1.3 Permit parking zone.

A. Parking by resident permit only in designated areas is effective on the following described streets or portions thereof in the borough.

- 100 Block of Anchor Avenue

7A-1.4 Issuance of permits.

A. Parking permit placards shall be issued through the Office of the Chief of Police, on an annual basis for automobiles and non-commercially registered pick-up trucks and vans. Applicants for such permits shall be required to present proof of residence.

B. Each eligible residence within the Borough will be entitled to a maximum of three permit placards at no cost. Replacement for lost or destroyed placards will be at a cost to the resident of two dollars per permit placard.

C. When a residence changes ownership the permit placards must be returned to the administrative office of the Chief of Police. The new homeowner will have to apply for the issuance of three new placards.

D. Permit placards issued shall be subject to all the conditions and restrictions set forth in this chapter and of the permit parking zone for which they were issued, including conditions or restrictions which may be altered or amended from time to time. The issuance of such permit shall not be construed to be a permit for, or approval of, any violation of any provisions of this code or any other law or regulation.

7A-1.5 Prohibitions.

A. Permit placards shall be affixed to the rear view mirror when parked on a street in the permit parking zone, this will make the permit placard visible to the enforcement officer from the street.

B. No vehicle displaying a permit placard shall be parked or stopped adjacent to any curb in a permit parking zone in violation of any posted or noticed prohibition or restriction.

C. It is unlawful for any person to sell, rent, transfer or lease, or cause to be sold, rented, transferred or leased, for any value or consideration or no value or consideration, any parking permit placard. Upon conviction for a violation of this subsection, all permit placards issued to, or for the benefit of, the dwelling unit for which the sold, rented, transferred or leased permit was authorized shall be void and returned to the administrative office in the municipal building.

D. It is unlawful for any person to acquire for value or otherwise use any parking permit placard, except as provided for in this chapter.

7A-1.6 Penalty for violation.

Unless another penalty is expressly provided by New Jersey Statute, every person convicted of a violation of a provision of this chapter or any supplement thereto shall be liable to a penalty of not more than \$100 or imprisonment for a term not exceeding 30 days or both.

7A-1.7 Exemptions.

A. People visiting residences in the permit parking zone will be required to display a permit placard in their vehicle. The visitor will obtain a permit placard from the residence they are visiting. When the person is done visiting, the permit placard will be removed from the vehicle and returned to the resident.

B. Residences having a party or large gathering where there are not enough permit placards to hand out will be required to notify the police department in advance.

C. Contractors, service and delivery vehicles bearing the name and address of a commercial business may park without a permit during the time they are rendering service to a residence within the permit parking zone.

D. Emergency vehicles and public service, telephone and other public utility vehicles may park without a permit during the time they are rendering service to a residence in the permit parking zone.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance repeals any inconsistent ordinance or ordinances or part or parts thereof.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its final passage and publication as required by law.
