Ordinance #494.2024

ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR ACQUISITION OF VARIOUS TECHNOLOGY HARDWARE FOR THE TOWNSHIP AND ITS EMPLOYEES, BY AND IN THE TOWNSHIP OF BETHLEHEM, IN THE COUNTY OF HUNTERDON, STATE OF NEW JERSEY; APPROPRIATING \$8,000 THEREFOR FROM THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND TO PAY FOR THE COST THEREOF

WHEREAS, the Township of Bethlehem, in the County of Hunterdon, State of New Jersey (the "Township"), wishes to provide for the acquisition of Various Technology Hardware for the Township and its employees in and for the Township, and shall also include all equipment, accessories, materials and work necessary therefor or incidental thereto (the "Technology Capital Purchase"); and

WHEREAS, the cost of said Technology Capital Purchase is estimated to be \$8,000; and

WHEREAS, the Township desires to authorize the appropriation and expenditure of \$8,000 from the Capital Improvement Fund to accomplish the aforesaid Technology Capital Purchase.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE TOWNSHIP OF BETHLEHEM, IN THE COUNTY OF HUNTERDON, STATE OF NEW JERSEY (a majority of the full membership thereof affirmatively concurring), AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The capital improvement or purpose described in Section 2 of this capital ordinance is hereby authorized as general capital improvement to be undertaken by the Township. There is hereby appropriated the amount of \$8,000 from the Capital Improvement Fund of the Township for said improvement or purpose stated in Section 2 hereof.

SECTION 2. The capital improvement or purpose hereby authorized is to provide for the acquisition of a Various Computer Equipment by and in the Township, and shall also include all equipment, accessories, materials and work necessary therefor or incidental thereto.

SECTION 3. The appropriation of \$8,000 from the Capital Improvement Fund of the Township, is hereby authorized and approved. The Mayor, the Clerk, the Chief Financial Officer and any other official/officer of the Township are each hereby authorized and directed to execute, deliver and perform any agreement to undertake the improvement or purpose set forth herein and to effectuate the transactions contemplated hereby.

SECTION 4. The capital budget of the Township is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this capital ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency herewith and a resolution in the form promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full detail of the amended capital budget and capital programs as approved by the Director of the Division of Local Government Services, New Jersey Department of Community Affairs is on file in the office of the Clerk and is available for public inspection.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall take effect immediately after final adoption and approval by the Mayor as described in N.J.S.A. 40:49-2.
