

ORDINANCE # 12-26

ORDINANCE AMENDING §162-19 LICENSE FEE; PROVISIONAL LICENSE OF THE CODE OF THE VILLAGE OF BELGIUM, OZAUKEE COUNTY, WISCONSIN

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Village Board of the Village of Belgium, Ozaukee County, Wisconsin, that §231 Article II of the Code of the Village of Belgium are hereby amended to read as follows:

§ 162-19 License fee; ~~provisional license;~~ temporary license.

- A. Fee. The fee for an operator's license shall be \$25 per year.
- B. Provisional license. The Village Clerk shall issue provisional operators' licenses in accordance with § 125.17(5) and (6), Wis. Stats., at a cost per license as set by the Village Board, so issued to a person who has applied for an operator's license and who is enrolled in a training course under § 125.17(6), Wis. Stats. A provisional operator's license shall expire 60 days after its issuance or when an operator's license is issued to the holder, whichever is sooner. A provisional license may not be issued to any person who has been denied an operator's license by the Village Board or who has had his operator's license revoked or suspended the preceding 12 months. The Village Clerk shall provide an appropriate application form to be completed in full by the applicant. The Village Clerk may revoke the provisional license issued if he or she discovers that the holder of the license made a false statement on the application or if the applicant fails to successfully complete the training course in which the applicant enrolled.
- C. Temporary License. The Village Clerk shall issue temporary operators' licenses in accordance with § 125.17(4), Wis.Stats., at a cost per license as set by the Village Board, to a person who is employed by or donating there services to nonprofit corporations, for a period of no more than 14 days and has met all additional applicable requirements of §125.17. No person may hold more than 2 temporary licenses per year.


This Ordinance shall become effective upon passage and posting.
