Superintendent Storm explained that this could only be possible if the road is widen which would require that land be acquired from both sides of the road and then upgraded.

SENIOR RIDE PROGRAM

Supervisor Crosier led a discussion on the proposed Senior Ride Program. He reported that he is working with an area auto dealer regarding a lease or purchase of a vehicle for this proposed program with is being spearheaded by the Community Caregivers. Linda Carman volunteered to serve on a committee to do further research on this project. Supervisor Crosier is also investigating the availability of government surplus vehicles.

WASTEWATER PROJECT UPDATE

Supervisor Crosier stated that work to obtain easements for the construction of the waste water program is ongoing from both residents for the pump station and the BKW for the treatment facility. He further stated that the Sewer Ordinance draft has been submitted.

LIBRARY PROJECT

Councilman Golden reported on a meeting that occurred with representatives of the Masonic Order regarding the possible acquisition by the town of the Masonic Hall for use by the Library. No agreement was reached. However, consideration is being given to the idea of temporary rental of the building to house the library so that Town Hall renovations could move forward.

AMENDMENT TO ZONING ORDINANCE RESOLUTION #33

Supervisor Crosier stated that at the Public Hearing on the proposed amendment to the Zoning Ordinance all those present were in favor of such an amendment that would allow developers to consider construction of a senior citizens housing complex on Canaday Hill Rd. After discussion, Councilman Hamilton offered and moved the following resolution:

WHEREAS, The Town of Berne town Board has undertaken a process to amend the Zoning Ordinance, and WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Berne held a public hearing on the proposed amendments, and WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Berne completed Part I & II of the full Environmental Assessment For as per 6 NYCRR part 617, determining that there would be no significant negative environmental impacts as a result of adopting the proposed zoning ordnance amendment and formally issued a Negative Declaration,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Town Board of the Town of Berne adopt the zoning map extending the boundaries as follows:

The hamlet boundaries for the hamlet of Berne shall be modified to add to the TN- MU1 district an area that includes part of the school grounds, town owned property, the Fire Department and additional lands immediately adjacent to the existing hamlet. Additionally, the TN-MU-2 district shall be amended by removing a parcel of land not considered appropriate for the more intensive uses allowed in the TN-MU2 district.
