**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF BEAVER, BEAVER COUNTY,  
PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE 577 CODIFIED AS §1-208  
REMOVING THE RESIDENCE REQUIREMENT FOR THE BOROUGH  
MANAGER.**

WHEREAS, Beaver Borough Ordinance 577 as codified in the Borough's Code of Ordinances §1-208 states, "The Manager shall, within two years after his appointment, fix his residence with the Borough."; and


WHEREAS, Borough Council believes this provision to be outdated as it deals with the responsibilities of the Borough Manager and potentially restrictive in attracting candidates for the position.

NOW THEREFORE, by the Council of the Borough of Beaver, in lawful session duly assembled, it is hereby ORDAINED AND ENACTED as follows:

Ordinance 577 as codified in §1-208 of the Borough's Code of Ordinances is hereby rescinded and removed. Effective with the date of this Ordinance there will be no formal residency requirement for the Borough's Manager.
