ORDINANCE 867**

ORDINANCE FIXING THE TAX RATE FOR THE YEAR 2024

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Council of the Borough of Beaver, County of Beaver and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, as follows:

Beaver County underwent a court order countywide reassessment with new assessed values levied on all property within the County to be used with 2024 taxes.

Pursuant to 53 Pa.C.S.A. § 8823(b), Beaver Borough along with all other taxing bodies in Beaver County are required to reset the 2024 millage rate so that the total amount of taxes levied for that year against the real properties does not exceed the total amount it levied on the properties in the preceding year of 2023. Beaver Borough has done that through Resolution Number ~~2023-5~~ setting the millage rate at 3.28642.

The Borough under 53 Pa C.S.A. §8823(c) may establish by a separate vote a final tax rate for 2024 not more than 10% greater than the total amount it levied on the properties the preceding year.

That a tax is hereby levied on all real property within the Borough subject to taxation for the year 2024 and any years as follows until otherwise amended by Council:

Tax rate for general purposes, the sum of 3.58 mills on each dollar of assessed valuation, or the sum of 3.58 dollars on each one thousand dollars of assessed valuation.


That any ordinance, or part of ordinance, conflicting with this ordinance be and the same is hereby repealed insofar as the same affects this ordinance.


