Public Contributions on Agenda Items (5 minute) There was no public contribution on agenda items.		
Agenda Items – Reports:		
1	Engineer; Bryan Churilla, HRG Engineers - Mr. Churilla reported that a pre-construction meeting was held with Youngblood Paving Company; they will only complete paving on 2 streets in 2020, Teece and S. Fremont, which together comprise about half the project. Lincoln Avenue and the streets where Columbia Gas is doing work will be paved in 2021. The contractor will walk Lincoln Avenue to inspect the issues at several of the new crosswalks. - Camera work was started this week on the Dawson Avenue sewer lining project, which is an Alcosan GROW grant project. - A pre-construction meeting on the Memorial Park waterline project is scheduled for this week; the project is expected to begin next week and take about 5 days to complete. - The manhole project was awarded. - The Borough’s CDGB 47 Pre-application was approved and a full application will be submitted in the next week.	
2	Public Works; Jim Kelly, Superintendent - Mr. Kelly plans to sell 2 old lawnmowers. - Several residents have expressed concern about DPW vehicles going the wrong direction on one-way streets. Mr. Kelly stated that the street sweeper and leaf vacuum must go the direction that they do because the equipment that sweeps/vacuums is mounted on one side of the vehicle, and that side must be against the curb to properly sweep or vacuum. - Team Fishel was contacted about sidewalk restoration at Washington and Kendall Avenues; because of the utility poles, standard 2x4 handicapped mats at the curb cuts cannot be installed; the mats can be 2x3 maximum.	
Unfinished Business: Mr. Kelly reported that the Borough’s new bucket truck will arrive 11.06.2020.		
New Business: Ms. Cerminara questioned the height requirements for sidewalk curbs.		

Public Contributions on Non-Agenda Items (2 minutes):

- Tom Hrynda, 523 Roosevelt Avenue: Noted that when he served on Council, DPW had discretion to evaluate and list items on Municibid; also remarked on cracks at edges of new crosswalks on Lincoln.
