Public Contributions on Agenda Items (5 minutes) None		
Agenda Items – Reports:		
1	Andrew Bayne Memorial Library; Ellen Goodman, Director - Ms. Goodman stated that she had nothing to add to her written report. - Mr. Kelly reported that he is soliciting quotes for work on the library building exterior.	
2	Bellevue Parks; Bryan Churilla, HRG Engineer & DPW Superintendent - Mr. Churilla stated that he had nothing new to report. - He was contacted by Main Line Pools, and they want to set up a site visit in anticipation of the liner work, which they are confident will be completed this spring.	
Unfinished Business: - Mr. Pritchard stated that with the pool being a point of contention, he believes there should be a joint sidewalk plan with the County and Ross Township for easier foot access to the pool. - Ms. Goodman inquired as to the status of the summer concert series. Committee members agreed that the Borough should act very conservatively in terms of cost and safety, and suggested holding off on scheduling for now.		
New Business: - DAS Bahn noted that the Borough needs to hire a pool manager; intentions for opening will be discussed at the March Pre-Council meeting. - In terms of pavilion rentals, DAS Bahn suggest that they be permitted, with users agreeing to comply with any state and county mandates for COVID-19 restrictions. She will prepare a waiver for renters to sign in conjunction with the rental application.		

Public Contributions on Non-Agenda Items (2 minutes)

- Tom Hyrnda, 523 Roosevelt Avenue: Reported that he and the former DPW superintendent had spoken to someone about repairing the railings at the library. He will forward the name to the office.
- Kristin Difloramonte, BAGAA: Asked about the status of the retaining wall at Gillott Park. Mr, Kelly noted that the Borough has purchased Versa Lok blocks for the lower walls but he is having trouble finding the quantity of lumber required for the higher wall and is looking at alternatives.
