Public Contributions on Agenda Items (5 minute) There was no public contribution.		
Agenda Items – Reports:		
1	Engineer; Bryan Churilla, HRG Engineers - Mr. Churilla reported that grant applications for East and West Bellevue Station have again been submitted. - He also noted that he is moving forward with the 2021 paving project, and will get bids out soon.	
2	Public Works; Jim Kelly, Superintendent - Mr. Kelly reported that he has only received one bid to retrofit the Bellevue sign; the 3 ovals were previously retrofitted to LED and the plastic coverings replaced. Three Rivers Sign provided a bid of \$2,154.27 to convert the “Bellevue” portion of the sign to LED; Mr. Kelly noted that they are a West View business. This will be discussed at the June Pre-Council meeting. - He also reported that the retaining wall on N. Jackson has deteriorated a bit more; HRG has submitted a quote to survey the wall and adjacent street for about \$2,000; this will be added to the July Pre-Council meeting agenda. - In regard to the Streetscape project, he stated that the next phase will cover Lincoln Avenue from Meade Avenue to the Pizza Hut as well as the sidewalk up Balph Avenue to Bayne Park; no bumpouts are included in the design. The work will require additional survey because the previous survey did not go to the Pizza Hut, and the work on Balph was not contemplated. He further stated that there are sidewalks that need to be addressed, particularly in front of Classic Chevrolet. This will be an agenda item for the June Pre-Council meeting. - Mr. Kelly noted that DPW’s steam pressure washer is not operating; he would like to purchase a new one using funds from DPW’s capital line; because the excavator came in at about \$10,000 less than budgeted, there are sufficient funds to cover the \$4,000 - \$5,000 cost of the pressure washer.	
Unfinished Business:		
1	Gillott Park Retaining Wall In response to a question from Ms. Cerminara, Mr. Kelly reported that he reached out to a concrete company for alternatives to lumber, and the estimate came back at about 4 times	

	the cost of new wood. He added that Council may need to revisit what was initially approved for this project.
2	Street Name Change ▪ The Solicitor was consulted and expressed his opinion that this is as simple as Council approving the name change and alerting the County, the Post Office, and emergency responders.
New Business: ▪ There were no items of new business to discuss.	
Public Contributions on Non-Agenda Items (2 minutes): ▪ Joe Scioscia, 260 Lincoln Avenue: Stated that he hopes the Borough is not doing any more bumpouts as part of the Streetscape project.
