Public Contributions on Agenda Items (5 minutes) - Wendy Blazier, 532 Highland Place: Reported that the trash on the road to the dog park hasn't been emptied; that the pool has not been covered and is still filled; and asked about plans for the Halloween Parade. - Amy Robinson, 419 Dawson Avenue: Stated that she is part of the Committee for Community Day fireworks, and requested support for them in 2022; noted that the cost of fireworks for the event has increased from \$8,400 in 2021 to \$8,800 in 2022.

2	Library Hiring This is on the back burner for now.	
3	Halloween Parade Tamra Franklin, from 202 Tacos, reported on plans for the event that she is spearheading. She has 13 or 14 people who are ready to help with planning and at the event. The route will begin at Starr Avenue, continue to Ralph Avenue and finish at Bayne Park, where prizes will be awarded. Registration will be online, or onsite October 30 at 9:00 am, with the parade starting at 10:00 am. She is soliciting donations from local businesses for treat bags to be distributed to participants.
