Agenda Items – Reports:		
1	Treasurer, Joe Scioscia Mr. Scioscia reported that Borough year-end cash balances were a little ahead of the previous year.	
Unfinished Business:		
1	Ordinance 21-05, Event/Gathering Ordinance Committee members believe that this is something that should be moved to the Public Safety Committee because it involves possible street closures and potentially other public safety issues.	
2	Cell Tower Ordinance DAS Bahn will share the PSAB and Baton Rouge model ordinances with all Council members.	
New Business:		
1	2022 Budget - Mr. Scioscia noted that Bellevue has a great police department, but an expensive one and attributes this to the 10-hour shifts. He stated that the Police Chief has control over overtime. - Chief Sentner responded that Bellevue has a 24/7/365 Department with a 2-officer minimum at all times, and the only way to change the current structure is to change the contract. He noted that every time an officer calls, off, it results in overtime, and that overtime as not increased in line with salary increased over the years. The Department has implemented a new scheduling system that will allow the Chief to produce reports that will show the reason for overtime.	
2	Fee Schedule The DAS reported that she is working on a new comprehensive fee schedule.	
2	Hybrid Meeting Options Mr. McKelvey offered his assistance with exploring options to the Meeting Owl.
