Public Contributions on Agenda Items (5 minute) There was no public contribution.		
Agenda Items – Reports:		
1.	Engineer; Dan Barna, HRG Engineers - Mr. Barna noted that the Dakota and Tingley demolitions are slated to begin soon. - The Bayne Park Retaining Wall restoration and Dakota Townhouse demolitions should begin in 3-4 weeks. - HRG will complete engineering on the Orchard Avenue street restoration; the bricks will be replaced by asphalt. Mr. Barna reported that bids will be back before the July Council meeting.	
2.	Public Works; Jim Kelly, Superintendent - Mr. Kelly stated that the had nothing to add to his written report. - Mr. McKelvey inquired about the Dek Hockey rink and Mr. Kelly responded that he has no news; repeated attempts to engage Pittsburgh Dek Hockey have been unsuccessful. The Borough would need to execute an agreement with whatever organization will take over management of the program.	
Unfinished Business:		
1.	Bayne Park Retaining Wall Fencing Quote Mr. Kelly noted that the quote is for fencing around the new section of wall; it was less expensive for DPW to take on fence installation in order to keep the bids for wall restoration closer to the budget.	
2.	N. Jackson Retaining Wall Ms. Slavicek asked about the status; Mr. Kelly responded that the Borough has the geotech reports and Mr. Churilla is talking to the company who completed the geotech survey about scaling back their scope.	
New Business:		
1.	VPRP Application for Vacant Lot on Farragut Avenue Ms. Bahn noted that an application has been received; the lot sits between 2 parcels owned by the same company, who would like to use this for parking. This will be added to the agenda for the June Pre-Council meeting.	

2.	Paving Collaboration ▪ Council member Tom Hrynda, on behalf of Committee chair Edmondson, suggested that Bellevue consider coordinating and sharing paving bids to create economies of scale. Mr. Hrynda noted that Avalon is collaborating with Ben Avon and Emsworth on paving.
Public Contributions on Non-Agenda Items (2 minutes): ▪ Susan Stabnau, 264 Summit Avenue: Noted that “Improve the Vue” will be working to clean up along the Lincoln Avenue business district Saturday, June 11 from 8-10 am, and volunteers are welcome. The group will be picking up trash, pruning, weeding, and cleaning out tree pits.
