1	Andrew Bayne Memorial Library; Ellen Goodman, Director Ms. Goodman reported that the library had record numbers of participants in the Summer Reading Program.	
2	Bellevue Parks Update, Bryan Churilla, HRG Engineers - Mr. Churilla reported that September 23rd will be his last day with HRG Engineers because he is leaving to join Kolton Construction & Land Management. - Bayne Retaining Wall: the contractor is waiting on materials, and hopes to take receipt by mid to late September; in the meantime, DPW will excavate the site. - Bayne Library External Repairs: the contractor has requested that the Borough waive the standard HRG pollution insurance requirement as it doesn't really pertain to this project and would be prohibitively expensive for the contractor to obtain.

1	Library Boiler Repair Mr. Kelly reported that Climatech provided a quote of \$2,700 to repair the obvious problems with the boiler, down from their previous estimate of \$5,000+. This will be on the September Pre-Council meeting agenda for approval.
