Public Contributions on Agenda Items (5 minutes) There was no public contribution.		
Agenda Items – Reports:		
1	Andrew Bayne Memorial Library; Ellen Goodman, Director Mr. Kelly reported that he expects work on the exterior repairs to begin soon.	
2	Bellevue Parks Update, Rob Arnold & Dan Barna, HRG Engineers - Mr. Kelly noted that work on the Bayne Park retaining wall will start any day; the contractor inadvertently excavated the site (which DPW had planned to do to save costs) but will not charge the Borough for their error. - Mr. Arnold & Mr. Barna reported the Memorial Park Restroom Pavilion will break ground first thing in the spring of 2023. - Mr. Kelly stated that he met with the new President of Team Pittsburgh Dek Hockey, and an agreement for their management of the Borough’s Dek Hockey rink is expected in the spring. Mr. Kelly further noted that he has a copy of Richland’s agreement and will use that as a starting point. Bellevue residents will be given priority for use of the Rink.	
Unfinished Business:		
1	Dowden Memorial, Lincoln Avenue at Sheridan Avenue DAS Bahn shared Ms. Miller’s email regarding the memorial. Ms. Denton stated that the Borough just needs to pick a location, and what will be there. Mr. Kelly added that Pizza Hut should be approached if the plan is still to do something there. Ms. Denton wondered if the area to the right of Dollar General makes more sense.	
2	Pool Update - Mr. Kelly reported that water will soon be turned off, and some maintenance issues will be addressed. - A second meeting with Paul Morack from Avalon has been scheduled for October 10.	
New Business:		
1	Halloween Events - Trick or Treat will be held October 31 from 6-8 pm. - Tamra Kirk from 202 Tacos is still seeking donations of candy and small trinkets, as well as volunteers for the Parade and the activities following in Bayne Park. The Borough will again purchase small pumpkins for decorating.	

2	Barrier for Retaining Wall at Gillott Park ▪ The Borough's BCO has advised Mr. Kelly that a barrier must be installed above the retaining wall for safety purposes; he noted that a natural (landscape) barrier, such as boxwood, could be used. Mr. Kelly estimates the cost at about \$1,000.
3	Basketball Courts ▪ Mr. Kelly did some research and discovered that there are about 14 different standard sizes for basketball courts.
