Public Contributions on Agenda Items (5 minute) There was no public contribution.		
Agenda Items – Reports:		
1.	Engineer; Bryan Churilla, HRG Engineers - Mr. Churilla reported that September 23rd will be his last day with HRG Engineers because he is leaving to join Kolton Construction & Land Management, but will continue to respond to any requests from the Borough. - He noted that work on the demolition of 191, 193, & 195 Dakota Avenue has resumed after stopping due to complaints from the owners of 197 Dakota who are concerned about damage to their townhouse. - Mr. Churilla reported that a preconstruction meeting was held this morning for the Orchard Avenue paving project, which is expected to start soon, and will take about 6 weeks to complete. The subcontractor is removing bricks, and excavation is expected to take 3-4 weeks. - Block for the Bayne Avenue retaining wall has been ordered, and the contractor is waiting on delivery.	
2.	Public Works; Jim Kelly, Superintendent - Mr. Kelly reported that he had nothing to add to his written report. - He attended a Public Works conference last week, where solar energy and green initiatives were hot topics.	
Unfinished Business:		
1.	Dek Hockey Rink Mr. Kelly reported that Team Pittsburgh Dek Hockey has a new director, who reached out to him last week; he anticipates that they will be ready to take over management of Bellevue’s rink sometime in 2023.	
2.	Update: Electric Vehicle Program through Duquesne Light Mr. Kelly noted that there is nothing new to report.	
New Business:		
1.	Tree Removal on Walkway between Shade and North Avenues	

	▪ The property located at about 690 Shade is owned by Bellevue and there are several trees that are causing issues. Mr. Kelly noted that 2 trees absolutely need to be removed, and 4 should be. He has obtained a bid of \$6,700 and noted that there are utility wires running through the trees.
2.	Mr. McKelvey reported that Ross Township composts leaf and yard waste, and asked about Bellevue doing the same. Mr. Kelly and Ms. Bahn both reported that this is a labor intensive project that is heavily monitored by the ACHD for compliance with minimum temperatures, rodent infestations, trash, etc.
