Public Contributions on Agenda Items (5 minute) There was no public contribution.		
Agenda Items – Reports:		
1.	Engineer; Rob Arnold & Dan Barna, HRG Engineers - Mr. Arnold noted that HRG is ready to advertise for bids for the Borough’s 2023 paving program. - The Borough will apply for a CDBG 49 grant to demolish the single family residences at 325 Glaser Avenue and 134 Meade Avenue; the pre-application was approved. - Restoration on both Kendall and Orchard Avenues is nearly complete. - Mr. Arnold posed the possibility of the Borough applying for a Multi-Modal Transportation grant to offset the Borough’s share of the Citizen Way retaining wall.	
2.	Public Works; Jim Kelly, Superintendent - Mr. Kelly reiterated that work on Kendall and Orchard is 99.9% complete. Several speed humps have been installed, but need to be striped, and he has received several complaints about them. - He also reported that 2022 paving work has been completed. - Mr. Kelly noted that a new sinkhole has developed on Lincoln in front of Northwest Bank; he stated that the laterals there are questionable. - He also noted that there are several trees down on N. Starr Avenue. - In response to Ms. Edmondson’s question about manhole lining, Mr. Kelly responded that he will be looking into this more in 2023. Mr. Arnold suggested that the Borough apply for a PA Small Water & Sewer grant to do this.	
Unfinished Business:		
1.	Update: Electric Vehicle Program through Duquesne Light Mr. Kelly noted that the Borough will be submitting the program application for public use of the charging stations in the Borough’s lot off Hawley Avenue.	
New Business:		
1.	Shade Tree Commission The Commission has developed a Mission Statement and identified priorities; these documents and a report were provided for review and comment.
