Public Contributions on Agenda Items (5 minute): Joe Scioscia, 260 Lincoln Avenue: Stated, “I’m saying this at all of the Committee meetings. Apart from sewer fund, we are about \$80,000 behind where we were last year. I don’t want to be in a position where we can’t afford to pay employees. I am urging Council to watch their spending.” He also stated that the “significant dips” on Riverview Avenue “constitute a public safety matter” and that the “Borough has an obligation to remediate now that you’re on notice”.

Jackson retaining wall. - In response to a question regarding the status of East and West Bellevue station, Mr. Arnold stated that he will need to ensure the Borough is able to develop the properties in question.	
2.	Public Works; Jim Kelly, Superintendent - Mr. Kelly provided information about the new fuel pumps at the DPW garage; this will be added to the Pre-Council agenda. - Also noted that he will have a quote for installation of the new sound system in Council Chambers for the Pre-Council meeting. - Prices for a remote access system for the building have continued to increase. - Mr. Kelly has more information about lining the 3 manholes on Woodlawn that need to be re-lined due to a failure; this will be added to the Pre-Council meeting agenda. - The lighted snowflake decorations for Lincoln Avenue have been ordered, and are in stock.
