Public Contributions on Agenda Items (5 minutes): Joe Scioscia, 260 Lincoln Avenue: Stated, “Apart from the Sewer Fund, we are about \$80,000 behind where we were last year. I don’t want to be in a position where we can’t afford to pay employees. I am urging Council to watch their spending.”

b.	Bellevue Parks Update, Rob Arnold & Dan Barna, HRG Engineers; Jim Kelly, DPW Supt. - Mr. Barna reported that pre-applications for CDBG and GEDTF grants for the Bayne Memorial Park restroom facility were submitted last week to the QVCOG. - Mr. Kelly noted that water has been shut off to the Memorial Park bathhouse and fountains.

a.	Library Roof and AC Units Mr. Kelly reported that he has received quotes to repair the Library roof; Ms. Goodman asked about submitting a Keystone grant for the roof, as the grants are often awarded for preservation and sustainability projects.	
b.	Memorial Park Tennis Court Resurfacing and Fence Repair Mr. Kelly will obtain a confirmed quote and this will be on the October Pre-Council agenda for action.	
New Business:		
a.	Halloween Event - The Borough’s Halloween Parade is scheduled for Saturday, October 28th beginning at noon and is being spearheaded by Tamra Kirk from 202 Tacos. - As in past years, the parade will start in Avalon, proceed down Lincoln Avenue, head north on Balph and finish at Bayne Park. - Costume prizes will be handed out, and there will be pumpkin decorating and other activities for children at the Park.
