Public Contributions on Agenda Items (5 minute): None		
Agenda Items – Reports:		
1.	Engineer; Dan Barna, HRG Engineers - Mr. Barna advised that HRG had submitted for the RAISE grant, putting in for the remainder of the Streetscape cost. - Mr. Barna advised that PA Small Water and Sewer Grants had opened that day and they were perhaps going to apply for that for West Bellevue Station. - Mr. Barna advised that another pay app request would be coming before Council for the North Jackson wall. - Ms. Denton asked if HRG had any plans to do the crosswalks already done under Streetscape which are now in bad shape. Mr. Barna said that they would look at different options. - Pertaining to the North Jackson wall, Mr. Barna reported that the guiderail was installed that day, but it would remain closed for the duration of winter. - Mr. McKelvey asked about the need for extensions for grants and Mr. Barna advised that he did not see a need at this time. - Mr. Barna reported that he and Solicitor Racunas had met with the bonding company from the demolition. They said that they will pay, and that Mr. Barna, Solicitor Racunas, and the Borough would keep an eye on the situation. - Mr. Barna said that the Streetscape crew had said that the Borough would be their first new project in the spring.	
2.	Public Works; Joe Wright, Superintendent - Ms. Denton asked how the Borough was doing on salt and Mr. Wright replied that Public Works is in great shape. - Mr. McKelvey asked about the area around Orchard and Means. Mr. Wright reported that there is a blockage around that area where pipes aren't lined up. Public Works and HRG are discussing the matter.	
Unfinished Business:		
	CBA status Ms. Contes stated that she was unsure exactly of where the negotiations were, but that Mr. Kelly would update Council.	

New Business:	
1.	Transfer ownership of Maryland Ave-Summit to N. Balph Ms. Contes advised that Mr. Kelly had informed her that he would try to have a sample letter at Pre-Council.
2.	Advertise for summer help The Committee asked if the Borough would be advertising soon for DPW seasonal help, and Ms. Contes stated that they would be advertising on social media and on Savvy Citizen.
3.	GFI 3 phase protection for pool Mr. Wright talked about the need to repair the electrical connection or the pump filtration system at the pool and stated that the cost would be \$10,500 for new and \$8,500 for repair. Mr. McKelvey asked where this was budgeted from and if we had the money. Ms. Contes said that they would follow up with the answer.
4.	Bird Town Ms. Denton said that the Borough would need to hang Bird Town signs. She stated that the Bird Town Committee would be having their first meeting and they would propose sites for the signs to Public Works and the Borough.
