ORDINANCE NO. 23 - 01

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF BELLEVUE, A HOME RULE MUNICIPALITY IN THE COUNTY OF ALLEGHENY, IN THE COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA; AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 15-05 IN ORDER TO PROVIDE FOR ADDITIONAL REGULATIONS RELATING TO LARGE VEHICLES.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Bellevue, in the County of Allegheny and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same, in accordance with the provisions of the Act of Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, as follows:

SECTION 1: Section 2 of Ordinance 15-05 shall be amended to include the following:

“C. Travel restriction for vehicles above FHWA class 7

- a. By the authority granted by Section 4902(a) of the PA Vehicle Code, it shall be unlawful for any person to drive any vehicle or combination classed 8 or above under the FHWA classification on Bellevue Borough local roadways. The following exemptions apply:
 - i. Local deliveries to businesses along Lincoln Avenue (Bellevue Borough Business District) shall be exempt and no advanced notice is required.
 - i. Vehicles classed 8 and above delivering or needing access to residential areas or areas outside the established business district shall provide advance notice (72 hours) to the Borough police department and obtain
- a. Drivers violating 15-05 (2)(c) will be subject to a \$100.00 fine.”


SECTION 2: Any ordinance, or part thereof, conflicting with the provisions of this ordinance is hereby repealed insofar as the affects this ordinance.
