AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BERKELEY TERMINATING A CONTRACTUAL AGREEMENT WITH THE COUNTY OF SAINT LOUIS FOR THE PROVISION OF CODE ENFORCEMENT SERVICES

WHEREAS, The City of Berkeley, Missouri contracted with the County of Saint Louis to provide code enforcement services (building/swimming, pools and spa, residential, existing building, mechanical, electrical, plumbing, and explosives codes); and,

WHEREAS, this agreement was approved by Ordinance 4707 on April 18, 2022; and,

WHEREAS, the City is in the process of contracting with Safebuilt LLC, to provide plan review and code inspection services; and,

WHEREAS, Paragraph 9.2 of Article IX of the Agreement requires either party to give 90 days' notice of their intent terminate the Agreement

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BERKELEY, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City of Berkeley, Missouri, hereby approves submitting Notice of Termination of this Agreement to the County of Saint Louis, Missouri.


Section 2. That all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

As required by Paragraph 9.2 of Article IX of our *Agreement for Code Enforcement Services*, signed April 20, 2022, we are giving official notice of our intent to terminate our agreement with your Department providing all inspection, permitting, code enforcement, and plan review services to the City of Berkeley. This Notice to Terminate was approved by the Berkeley City Council by a majority vote on September 18, 2023. With this notification, we comply with the 90-day notice period required by our agreement. However; it is our understanding per the conversation with Kurt Juergens on August 22 of this year that the County has ceased intake of all new permit applications from Berkeley as of September 19.
