AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH ENVIRONMENTAL OPERATIONS INC ACCORDING TO BID #938 – ENVIRONMENTAL ABATEMENT OF 6140 N. HANLEY RD (OLD CITY HALL) (THE CITY DOES HEREBY FIND AND DECLARE THAT AN EMERGENCY EXISTS WHICH REQUIRES THE IMMEDIATE PASSAGE OF THIS ORDINANCE FOR THE PRESERVATION OF THE WELFARE OF THE CITIZENS OF THE CITY OF BERKELEY.)

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BERKELEY, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1.** The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute an Agreement for asbestos remediation service according to RFQ #938, Demolition of 6140 N. Hanley Road (Old City Hall), to Environmental Operations, Inc.
- Section 2.** The agreement is attached and hereby incorporated herein and made a part of this ordinance, as if fully set out herein.
- Section 3.** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its date of passage.
- Section 4.** The City does hereby find and declare that an emergency exists which requires the immediate passage of this ordinance for the preservation of the welfare of the citizens of the City of Berkeley.

SUBJECT: **Selection of Environmental Operations, Inc. to abate old city hall (6140 N. Hanley).**

BACKGROUND

The RFQ for this project was published in September, with a response deadline of October 11th. We received seven bids, of which the lowest and best bid was from Environmental Operations, Inc. I recommend them for the following reasons:

- They have the second lowest quoted fee (\$111,900).
- Their reputation based on comments received and my own personal experience is uniformly positive.
- Their bid package was the most complete.
- Concerns were raised by prior clients of the lowest bidder (Spray Services) about certain aspects of their work.

Environmental Operations, Inc. (EOI) is pleased to submit this proposal to you for Professional Asbestos Abatement Services at the above referenced subject site located in Berkeley Missouri. EOI will provide Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) accredited and Missouri licensed asbestos workers and a supervisor to conduct the scope of work. EOI will perform the abatement services in accordance with the Federal NESHAP, OSHA 29 CFR 1926.1101, and local regulations.

SCOPE OF WORK

EOI proposes to remove and properly dispose of the asbestos containing materials (ACM) identified in the asbestos survey completed by ENPAQ LLC dated September 2023. **Project #23-192**

CLARIFICATIONS/EXCLUSIONS

- EOI will remove all (ACM) materials in accordance with St. Louis County Ordinance 612.530 (7.1) procedures for full containment.
- The building owner will provide the necessary utilities (ie: water & electricity) to perform the abatement activities.
- EOI assumes once work commences, work will be completed without interruptions.
- Standard insurance requirements are included in this proposal.
- EOI understands the scope of work can be performed during the normal business hours of 7:00am-3:30pm Monday-Friday. No premium cost for off-hour work has been included in this proposal.

COSTS

Asbestos Abatement: \$ 111,900.00

The cost includes all materials, equipment, air monitoring, union labor, and waste disposal required to complete this project. EOI is available to begin the 10-day notification to St. Louis County Air Pollution Control Program upon receipt of a written notice to proceed.



PROJECT AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT made this 11 day October 2023, by and between the City of Berkeley (a municipal corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Missouri), hereinafter called the "Owner" and Environmental Operations (a partnership, corporation or an LLC) hereinafter called the "Contractor" and the City of Berkeley, Missouri.

WITNESSETH, that the Contractor and the City of Berkeley, Missouri for the considerations stated herein agree as follows:

STATEMENT OF WORK: The Contractor shall furnish all supervision, technical personnel, labor, materials, machinery, and services and perform and complete all work required for the Remediation and removal of asbestos containing materials in the structure located at 6140 N. Hanley Road, within the City of Berkeley, Missouri; and site restoration, traffic control measures and any and all required supplemental work for completion of the project in accordance with the Contract documents.

The Contractor must contact the City at least five (5) working days prior to start of project so that residents can be notified of project commencement date.

The Contractor shall receive direct pay from the City of Berkeley for the performance of the contract in current funds, for work performed at the prices stipulated on the attached bid for the work completed subject to any additions and deductions mutually agreed upon by both parties of this agreement.

CONTRACT: The executed Contract documents consist of the documents furnished to each bidder and the Contractor for this project.
