122-6 AREAS OF SPECIAL FLOOD HAZARD

The areas of special flood hazard are identified and defined on the following documents prepared by the Federal Emergency Management Agency:

- (1) Flood Insurance Rate Maps: 36029C0337H whose effective date is June 7, 2019, and any subsequent revisions to these map panels that do not effect areas under our community's jurisdiction
- (2) A scientific and engineering report entitled "Flood Insurance Study, Erie County, New York (All Jurisdictions)" dated June 7, 2019.

The above documents are hereby adopted and declared to be part of this Local LAW. The Flood Insurance Study and/or maps are on file at: 121 Miriam Avenue, Blasdell, Ny 14219.

112-7 INTERPRETATION AND CONFLICT WITH OTHER LAWS

- A. This Local LAW includes all revisions to the National Flood Insurance Program through October 27, 1997 and shall supercede all previous laws adopted for the purpose of flood damage prevention.
- B. In their interpretation and application, the provisions of this local law shall be held to a minimum requirements, adopted for the promotion of public health, safety and welfare. Whenever the requirements of this local law are at variance with the requirements of any other lawfully adopted rules, regulations or ordinances, the most restrictive, or that imposing the higher standards, shall govern.

122.7-1 SEVERABILITY

The invalidity of any section or provision of this local law shall not invalidate any other section or provision thereof.

122.10 DESIGNATION OF THE LOCAL ADMINISTRATOR

The Town of Hamburg Office of Building Inspection is hereby appointed Local Administrator to administer and implement this local law by granting or denying floodplain development permits in accordance with its provisions.

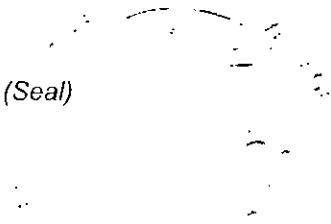
