§ 2: Section 125-7 B. of the Village Code shall be amended to add a third row in the chart listing highways within the Village where trucks with a gross weight of 12 tons or greater are excluded with that chart now reading as follows:

Name of Street	Location

Oakmount Avenue	Between the intersection of Routes 5 and 20 and Main Street
Main Street	Between the intersection of Main Street and Maple Avenue west to the Village limits.
