A LOCAL LAW, TO AMEND TOWN CODE CHAPTER 111, *TAXATION* THROUGH THE ENACTMENT OF A LOCAL LAW ESTABLISHING A REAL PROPERTY TAXATION EXEMPTION BASED UPON DISABILITY

BE IT ENACTED BY THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF BOSTON AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. LEGISLATIVE INTENT

This Local Law is intended to grant a reduction in the amount of property taxes paid by qualifying persons with disabilities as defined in Real Property Tax Law Section 459-c.

SECTTION 2.

CHAPTER 111 – TAXATION

That Taxation, codified at Chapter 111 of the Boston Town Code, be and it is hereby amended to create a new Section 4 to read in its entirety as follows:

ARTICLE IV

Partial Exemption of Disabled Persons

9 §111-4. Exemption Stated.

The Town Board of the Town of Boston, hereby grants to taxpayers within the Town of Boston with a disability as defined in Real Property Tax Law of the State of New York, Section 459-c a partial exemption from real property taxation to the extent of 50% of the excess valuation of said property to said taxpayers within the Town of Boston in compliance with the requirements specified in §111-4.1 as to the extent of and the eligibility for said tax exemption.

SECTION 3.

MISCELLANEOUS

- A. This Local Law shall be deemed to supersede and repeal any other Local Laws to the extent therein inconsistent herewith.
- B. If any part of this Local Law shall be judicially declared invalid, void, unconstitutional or unenforceable, all unaffected provisions hereof shall survive such declaration and this Local Law shall remain in full force and effect as if the invalidated portion had not been enacted
- C. Nothing herein shall be deemed to be a waiver or restriction upon any rights and powers available to the Town of Boston to further regulate the subject matter of this Local Law.

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Local Law shall become effective upon filing with the Secretary of State of the State of New York, as required by the Municipal Home Rule Law.
