# LOCAL LAW NO 1

## **OF**

## THE YEAR 2006

A LOCAL LAW TO REZONE 8964 BOSTON STATE ROAD WHICH CONTAINS APPROXIMATELY 5.59 acres of land [SBL no. 241.00-3-12.1] from C-1 (Local Retail Business District) to C-2 (General Commercial District)

BE IT ENACTED BY THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF BOSTON AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1.

#### LEGISLATIVE INTENT

Local Law No. 1 of the Year 2006 shall amend Local Law No. 6 of the Year 1990, any amendments thereto and the Town of Boston zoning map, by rezoning 8964 Boston State Road which contains 5.59 acres more or less of real property [SBL no. 241.00-3-12.0] from C-1 to C-2; such property being described as Town of Boston, Erie County, New York, Lot 3, Township 8, Range 7 of the Holland Land Company's survey and located on the west side of Boston State Road, with a legal description as follows:

ALL THAT TRACT OR PARCEL OF LAND situate in the Town of Boston, County of Erie and State of New York, being part of Lot No. 3, Township 8, Range 7 of the Holland Land Company's Survey, bounded and described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point on the center line of Boston State Road distant 165.75 feet southerly thereon from the intersection thereof with the southerly line of lands conveyed to Paul Fleissner by a deed recorded in the Erie County Clerk's Office in Liber 746 of Deeds at page 83, which southerly line of Fleissner is also the northerly line of lands conveyed to Truman S. Cary by a deed so recorded in Liber 243 of Deeds at page 102; thence northerly along said center line of Boston State Road195.75 feet to a point 30 feet northerly thereon from the intersection thereof with said southerly line of lands of Fleissner and northerly line of lands of Cary, which point is also the south-east corner of lands conveyed to Donald E. Brunner, Sr. and others by a deed so recorded in Liber 9565 of Deeds at page 297; thence westerly along the southerly line of said lands of Brunner and others, and parallel to said southerly line of Fleissner, 866 feet more or less to the easterly bank of Eighteen Mile Creek; thence south-westerly along said bank, 371

feet more or less to a point where a line drawn westerly through the point of beginning at right angles to the center line of Boston State Road would intersect the east bank of Eighteen Mile Creek; thence north-easterly along said line, 1,096 feet more or less to the point or place of beginning.

#### SECTION 2. THE FOLLOWING IS HEREBY ADOPTED:

The uses permitted by the zoning amendment contained in this Local law shall be subject to limitations and / or conditions adopted contemporaneously herewith by the Town Board of the Town of Boston pursuant to §123-177 of the Boston Town Code.

#### SECTION 3. MISCELLANEOUS

- A. This Local Law shall be deemed to supersede and repeal any other Local Laws to the extent therein inconsistent herewith.
- B. If any part of this Local Law shall be judicially declared invalid, void, unconstitutional or unenforceable, all unaffected provisions hereof shall survive such declaration and this Local Law shall remain in full force and effect as if the invalidated portion had not been enacted.
- C. Nothing herein shall be deemed to be a waiver or restriction upon any rights and powers available to the Town of Boston to further regulate the subject matter of this Local Law.

#### SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Local Law shall become effective upon filing with the Secretary of State of the State of New York, as required by the Municipal Home Rule Law.
