LOCAL LAW NO 2

OF

THE YEAR 2010

A LOCAL LAW TO AMEND SECTION 118-2A of the Code of the Town of Boston to prohibit parking or standing of any vehicle on Boston Cross Road, CR 190, on the north side, from the east side of Boston State Road easterly for a distance of four hundred and fifty (450) feet excluding therefrom that portion of Boston Cross Road which is located directly in front of the buildings located at 6857, 6861, 6865 and 6869 Boston Cross Road which is reserved for residential parking.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF BOSTON AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. LEGISLATIVE INTENT

Local Law No. 2 of the Year 2010 shall amend Section 118-2A of the Code of the Town of Boston, adopted February 1, 1967, by adding the prohibition of parking or standing of any vehicle on Boston Cross Road, CR 190, on the north side, from the east side of Boston State Road easterly for a distance of four hundred and fifty (450) feet excluding therefrom that portion of Boston Cross Road which is located directly in front of the buildings located at 6857, 6861, 6865 and 6869 Boston Cross Road which is reserved for residential parking.

SECTION 2. MISCELLANEOUS

- A. This Local Law shall be deemed to supersede and repeal any other Local Laws to the extent therein inconsistent herewith.
- B. If any part of this Local Law shall be judicially declared invalid, void, unconstitutional or unenforceable, all unaffected provisions hereof shall survive such declaration and this Local Law shall remain in full force and effect as if the invalidated portion had not been enacted.
- C. Nothing herein shall be deemed to be a waiver or restriction upon any rights and powers available to the Town of Boston to further regulate the subject matter of this Local Law.

SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Local Law shall become effective upon filing with the Secretary of State of the State of New York, as required by the Municipal Home Rule Law.
