## **ORDINANCE #932**

## AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF BOONTON, COUNTY OF MORRIS, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, TO AMEND THE TOWNSHIP CODE TO REVISE WATER AND SEWER RATES

**WHEREAS**, the Township of Boonton has determined there is a need to increase certain annual sewer charges and water consumption charges for 2024; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township Committee has reviewed the proposed changes and determined that it is in the best interest of the Township to authorize same.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED**, by the Township Committee of the Township of Boonton, County of Morris, State of New Jersey, as follows:

**SECTION 1.** Part II: General Legislation, Chapter 82 Fees, § 82-1, Fee schedule established, Ch. 121, Sewers, is hereby amended as follows:

## Annual sewer charges:

Residential users/per unit	\$456 per annum
Commercial users	\$4.48/1,000 gallons based on prior billing year water consumption
Rockaway Valley School	\$4.48/1,000 gallons based on number of students plus
	number of staff x 15 gpd x 180 days
Nursing Homes	\$4.48 /1,000 gallons based on number of students plus
	number of staff x 15 gpd x 365 days
Victoria Mews	\$4.48 /1,000 gallons based on number of units x 125
	gallons x 365 days

**SECTION 2.** Part II: General Legislation, Chapter 82 Fees, § 82-1, Fee schedule established, Ch. 148, Water, is hereby amended as follows:

Water consumption charges:	

First 5,000 gallons	\$117/quarter
5,000 gallons through 8,500 gallons	\$1.66/1,000 gallons
8,500 gallons through 14,000 gallons	\$21.12/1,000 gallons
14,000 gallons through 17,000 gallons	\$22.90/1,000 gallons
17,000 gallons through 20,000 gallons	\$23.87/1,000 gallons
20,000 gallons through 27,000 gallons	\$24.92/1,000 gallons
In excess of 27,000 gallons	\$26.89/1,000 gallons

- **SECTION 3**. Ordinances, resolutions, regulations or parts of ordinances, resolutions and regulations inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistencies.
- **SECTION 4**. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such a decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance.
- **SECTION 5.** This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publication in the manner according to law.
