**ORDINANCE 2026-003**

**MODIFYING CITY CODE § 258-13, PARKING PROHIBITED FOR STREET  
CLEANING REGARDING PRINCE STREET EAST AND WEST**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Bordentown (“City”) maintains restrictions on street parking to facilitate effective municipal services; and

**WHEREAS**, Section § 258-13 of the City Code, most recently amended by Ordinance Number 2009-16 on October 26, 2009, prohibits parking for certain streets and at certain times within the City’s limits; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Commissioners has determined that amending the parking schedule for Prince Street is necessary to ensure the health, safety, and welfare of the residents by allowing for efficient street cleaning;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Bordentown, County of Burlington, State of New Jersey, that City Code § 258-13 is modified as follows regarding Prince Street, East and West:

- Parking on East Prince Street shall be prohibited on Mondays between West Chestnut Street and Park Street between the hours of 1:00 pm and 3:00 pm.
- Parking on West Prince Street between West Chestnut Street and Park Street shall be prohibited on Mondays between the hours of 10:00 am and 12:00 pm.

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** that the City Department of Public Works is hereby authorized and directed to install, remove, or modify any and all parking and traffic control signage within the City’s limits as necessary to accurately reflect the amendments set forth herein, in accordance with N.J.S.A. 39:4-183.27 and the most recent Manual on Uniform Traffic

Control Devices (MUTCD) and applicable law as adopted by the New Jersey Department of Transportation.


**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** that all ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby modified or repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** that if any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause, or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision so adjudged and the remainder of the Ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective.

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED**, that this ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and publication according to law.
