TOWN OF BOONTON ORDINANCE 14-24

ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR BOONTON AVE PARKING LOT RESURFACING TO BE UNDERTAKEN IN AND BY THE TOWN OF BOONTON, IN THE COUNTY OF MORRIS, NEW JERSEY, AND APPROPRIATING \$150,000 THEREFOR FROM VARIOUS FUNDS OF THE TOWN

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF BOONTON, IN THE COUNTY OF MORRIS, NEW JERSEY, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The improvements described in Section 2 of this ordinance are hereby authorized as general improvements to be made or acquired by the Town of Boonton, New Jersey. For the said improvements or purposes stated in said Section 2, there is hereby appropriated the sum of \$150,000, to the extent of \$25,000, from moneys available in the Capital Improvement Fund of the Town, and to the extent of \$125,000 from the proceeds of a grant received or to be received by the Town from the NJ Department of Community Affairs, as grants-in-aid of financing said improvement to the Resurfacing of the Boonton Avenue Parking Lot.

Section 2. The improvement hereby authorized and the purposes for which said appropriation is made is as follows: (a) the improvement of various Town parking facilities including, without limitation, the resurfacing and renovation of the Parking Lot at Boonton Avenue, together with for all the aforesaid equipment, accessories, attachments, work and materials, necessary therefor or incidental thereto, all as shown on and in accordance with the plans and specifications therefor on file or to be filed in the office of the Town Clerk and hereby approved.

Section 3. The capital budget or temporary capital budget of the Town is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency herewith and the resolutions promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing all detail of the amended capital budget or temporary capital budget and capital program as approved by the Director, Division of Local Government Services are on file with the Town Clerk and are available for public inspection.

This ordinance shall take effect after publication after final adoption, as provided by law.
