A BILL TO BE KNOWN AS ORDINANCE NO. 2004

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING AND FIXING THE ANNUAL RATE OF TAXATION FOR THE YEAR 2024 TO BE LEVIED BY THE CITY OF BOWLING GREEN, MISSOURI ON ALL TAXABLE PROPERTY WITHIN THE SAID CITY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Aldermen of the City of Bowling Green, Missouri as follows, to-wit:

SECTION I

For the purposes of providing funds for the current expenses of the city administration and for the purposes of administration of city government generally, there shall be and is hereby levied for the year 2024, a tax of sixty-three and eighty-two hundredth cents (\$0.6382) on each one hundred dollars (\$100) assessed valuation of all taxable property within the city limits as set and approved by the Board of Equalization in Pike County, Missouri and certified pursuant to the

statutes of the State of Missouri.

SECTION II

For the purpose of maintenance of the Bowling Green, Missouri cemetery, there shall be and is hereby levied for the 2024 a tax of nine and eighty-four hundredth cents (\$0.0984) on each one hundred dollars (\$100) assessed valuation of all taxable property within the city limits as set and approved by the Board of Equalization in Pike County, Missouri and certified pursuant to the statutes of the State of Missouri.

SECTION III

For the purpose of maintenance of the Bowling Green, Missouri library there shall be and is hereby levied for the 2024 a tax of nineteen and seventy hundredth cents (\$0.1970) on each one hundred dollars (\$100) assessed valuation of all taxable property within the city limits as set and approved by the Board of Equalization in Pike County, Missouri and certified pursuant to the

statutes of the State of Missouri.

SECTION IV

All Ordinances in conflict herewith or to the same effect hereof are hereby ordered repealed.
