A BILL TO BE KNOWN AS ORDINANCE NO. 2005

AN ORDINANCE SETTING THE WATER AND SEWER RATES AND CHARGES OF THE BOWLING GREEN, MISSOURI CITY CODE FOR FISCAL YEAR 2024-2025

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Aldermen of the City of Bowling Green, Missouri as follows, to-wit:

SECTION I

SECTION 705.220: Water Rates for the City of Bowling Green, Missouri City Code hereby sets the minimum user charge per billing cycle shall be fourteen dollars and seventy-nine cents (\$14.79). In addition, each customer shall pay a user rate charge of twelve dollars and forty-six cents (\$12.46) per one thousand (1,000) gallons of water.

SECTION II

SECTION 705.240: Water Rate Outside The City Limits of the Bowling Green,

Missouri City Code hereby sets the minimum user charge per billing cycle shall be twenty-one dollars and eighteen cents (\$21.18). In addition, each customer shall pay a user charge of eighteen dollars and seventy cents (\$18.70) per one thousand (1,000) gallons of water.

SECTION III

SECTION 705.245: Water Rate to Contract Customer, Ameren UE. In accordance with the Contract with Ameren UE, the City is to provide water to Ameren UE at the overhead and maintenance cost per 1,000 gallons as calculated each year. Accordingly, water usage by Ameren UE for 2024/2025 shall be paid in the amount of twelve dollars and sixty-five cents (\$12.65) per 1,000 gallons.

SECTION IV

SECTION 710.150: User Charge Rates. The minimum charge per billing period shall be nine dollars and thirty-five cents (\$9.35). In addition, each contributor shall pay a user charge rate for operation and maintenance including replacement of eleven dollars and twenty-three cents (\$11.23) per one thousand (1,000) gallons of water as determined in the preceding section. The charges shall be revised from time to time in accordance with Section 710.180.

SECTION V

SECTION 710.155: Sewer Usage Outside City Limits. The minimum charge per billing shall be eleven dollars and two cents (\$11.02). In addition, there shall be a user charge rate for operation and maintenance of fifteen dollars and seventeen cents (\$15.17) per one thousand gallons of water used at such locations. The charges shall be revised from time to time in accordance with Section 710.180.

SECTION VI

All Ordinance in conflict herewith or to the same effect hereof are hereby ordered repealed. This Ordinance to be in full force and effect from and after its date of passage and approval.
