Directors Report:

Nexus Lexus canceled for this evening.

Recreation Center: There are issues with the toilets in the new recreation center. Some of the toilets don't flush and urinals overflow. The O rings are going bad. Per conversation with American Standard there have been upgrades to the system. Both the automatic system and manual systems have problems. We have asked them send a rep to confirm installed correctly. Buttons have been sent by American Standard. It's under warranty for 5 years. We can get one of the manual systems from the company. We can change one to see if it works to change to manual. Fix the buttons first and then change to manual if there's still a problem.

Policy change: Field & Park Usage #11 - check availability prior to accepting application fee.

Tea Street Field: reached out to little league but no meeting has been set yet. Little league pays each year for the irrigation. A meeting between Rec and Little League needs to be set up prior to Little League using the field.

Codrington Park: The filter project is going out to bid. There will be a walk through on March 13 to view project. Bids need to be submitted 30 days later. The contract should be set by the end of April. It should only take a week to 2 weeks to install the filters.

Planter project – remove fence and put up a rock planter wall. We will need to wait until filter bid comes in. DPW can take the fence down.
