Engineers Report – T&M Associates – January 1- 31

Dale Leubner reported:

Army Corp of Engineer is working on drainage line and Main Street. Received a complaint from a Main Street business about their front entranceway. Dale will be addressing that to the Army Corp. They should be off of Main Street within the week. There will be no more road closures and tie-ups.

FEMA will be coming to the town to hold a meeting to discuss flood insurance and remapping.

Robert Keady reported:

Basin 4 Rehab is 2 projects; Proposal A and B.

Project has been slowed because of weather.

2013 Road Improvement Program will reconvene in the spring to complete the work.

2014 Road Improvement Program- design is underway; project to be advertised in the spring.

2015 CDBG application is due March 20th. Mr. Keady advised there was sanitary sewer damage at Talmadge Avenue due to a collapsed pipe. He recommended that this would be a good project. This would go right up to the MCUA Pump Station.

The council stated that the engineer's presentation to the county is very important.

Dale Leubner advised on areas that the public raised concerns with at the last engineers meeting. He had an inspector look at West Main Street. He will get an update from inspector.

There were icy concerns on Maple and Hayward. Water is ponding in gutter. On Helfin Street being very flat, water does not move. Look at drains and inlets. Will keep in mind when we start road programs.

Mayor Fazen advised will be meeting with PSE&G to discuss the completion of their high pressure underground pipe project.

Also the repaving of roads that they have destroyed.

C. Gomez suggested the work being done between June 20 and September 9 if done this year. There will be less impact when school is out.

Councilwoman Pranzatelli asked for a status on the quiet zone. Mr. Keady advised that this is back to the town's risk manager as to impact to the insurance increases.

C. Fiadino advised he received a letter from a Mrs. Roberto regarding traffic concerns by Shop-Rite. He will send the letter to the engineer for review. .

John Buckley-232 West Main Street

Mr. Buckley thanked the governing body for considering him as one of the candidates to fill the open seat on council. The committee looked at my work schedule as to whether there would be a conflict to commit the time to the seat.

He followed up on a request brought to the engineer to look at 291 West Main Street where resident's sidewalk was regarded. The water flushes down the driveway.

At 232 West Main Street he advised that the expansion joint expanded or is dissolving on the apron going between the street and sidewalk. Now there is a gap. This will be brought to the engineer's attention as well.

He asked for an update on the railroad tracks. Mayor Fazen advised that New Jersey Transit will make those repairs in two weeks.

Engineers were excused.

John Paul Levin-269 Metape North

He presented a question on the Special Improvement District. Does the executive director of the SID replace the downtown manager?

The council advised that the Board hires a downtown manager.

SID's usually hire a downtown manager but there is nothing that requires them to.

Mr. Levin asked if there are negotiations for further redevelopment of the downtown. Mayor Fazen advised it will be discussed in executive session.

Mr. Levin suggested to the council in negotiations that the developer help out with public works equipment and police, fire and rescue.

Mayor Fazen read by title:

RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF A REDEVELOPMENT AGREEMENT CONDITIONALLY DESIGNATING MERIDIA, LLC, A CAPODAGLI PROPERTY COMPANY, LLC AS REDEVELOPER FOR PROPERTY KNOWN AS TAX BLOCK 1, LOTS 42 AND 43 LOCATED IN THE DOWNTOWN REDEVELOPMENT AREA FOR REDEVELOPMENT OF RESIDENTIAL AND MIXED USE DEVELOPMENT

Discussion: Attorney Judy Verrone advised Section 3.05 in the agreement is going to be amended – Redeveloper agrees to contribute \$200,000 for use and renovation of the Bound Brook Train Station structures, platforms, waiting areas and related facilities.

The \$200,000 will be deposited upon issuance by the town for the first construction permit for project; except that if the \$200,000 is required for rehabilitation prior to first permit, the redeveloper shall deposit funds to the town upon notice and reasonable verification of such need to the redeveloper.

In the event the rehabilitation does not occur prior to issuance of certificate of occupancy for first unit, the town will have the right to use the \$200,000 for any other lawful purpose along with consultation with the redeveloper.


