

A regular meeting of the Bound Brook Board of Health was called to order at 7:30 p.m. in the borough hall. The following answered roll call:

Also present was Sanitarian Mr. Charles Martarano, Health Officer Dr. Ronald Cohen and Attorney Mr. George Psak. Absent was Susanne Morrissey and Mr. John Andrade.

#### PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

Mr. Plesa and Mr. Barglowski - Subject: Individual applying to the Board of Health to raise pigs. Neighbors complaining of stench and rats infestation. Mr. Plesa feels your in an industrial park zone and the upper part is in a R4 zone, one or two family dwelling. He does not feel this is proper. Hopes that the board would take into consideration the problems that would exist. Dr. Cohen read a letter addressed to Mr. Al Vischetti, a copy was sent to Mr. Orlando and Mr. Locklear, 294 W. Main St., Bound Brook. ( the party being discussed ) The Locklear's sent a letter saying their son had joined the 4H Fair and was going to bring in 3 pigs for him to take care of as a 4H project. Inspected the property and gave Mr. Locklear the following information:

(1) Board of Health Ordinance 1-84 regulates the keeping of animals in Bound Brook.

(2) Mr. Locklear stated he has seven acres of land, this should be verified.

(3) The ordinance requires and inclosure for the animals at least one hundred foot from each lot line or any other occupied residence. He currently has a black horse and a brown and white pony which are kept in a modified trailer. The premises are clean but not of a design to keep pigs.

(4) Mr. Locklear was told to prepare a map of his property with the exact dimensions and to show the location where he will build a seperate enclosure, retaining for the pigs. After he submits the sketch for approval Mr. Veschetti will visit the site prior to investing any money in the actual construction.

(5) Mr. Locklear was given a copy of Ordinance 1-84 and informed that he must have one acre of land per animal, exclusive of the area occupied by a residential unit or included in required set backs.

(6) Mr. Locklear was informed that he still must meet any standards set by the zoning or planning board of the Mayor and Council of keeping of animals and is subject to periodic inspections to make sure he does not cause a nuisance .

(7) Mr. Locklear was informed that his property hinges on the flood plain. There are restrictions and limitations on use on lands in the flood plain.

#### ACCEPTANCE OF THE MINUTES

Mrs. Mackinson asked for any additions or corrections in the December minutes. There were none. Mrs. Mackinson asked that the December minutes be accepted as read. This was made by Mr. Motyka, seconded by Dr. Davis and passed by the board members.

#### REPORTS

There was no meeting of the Commission because of the holiday. They did vote at the commission meeting to change procedure on handling rodent problems. This was based on the city of Edision. Their Mayor and Council just passed a resolution to discontinue all rodent baiting. We will provide bait but they must physically pick it up from our office. We will provide bait stations, with a \$ 5.00 deposit. They will get the deposit back when they return the bait station. They also provide liquid bait with the instructions. Before we give them the bait we will inspect the property and tell them what to do. Dr. Cohen passed out Activities and Nurses report to the board members.

Charles Martarano's reports were read and filed.

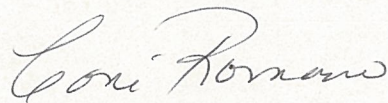
