ORDINANCE NO. 2026-05

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE BOROUGH CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF BOUND BROOK CHAPTER 2, ARTICLE VI ENTITLED “DEPARTMENTS ESTABLISHED”, SPECIFICALLY SECTION 23 ENTITLED “DEPARTMENT OF RECREATION”

WHEREAS, Chapter 2, Article VI entitled “Departments Established” specifically Section 23 of the Borough Code of the Borough of Bound Brook establishes the Department of Recreation; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Bound Brook have determined that the Department of Recreation should be amended.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Bound Brook, County of Somerset, State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 2, Section 23, “Department of Recreation”, is hereby amended and supplemented by deleting the text **[marked in bold and enclosed in brackets]** and inserting the text **underlined and marked in bold**, to read as follows:

§ 2-23 Department of Recreation.

§ 2-23.1 Recreation Department Established.

There is hereby established in the Borough a Recreation Department, which shall administer all Borough-approved programs and activities.

§ 2-23.2 Recreation **[Director] Superintendent**.

The Recreation **[Director] Superintendent** shall have the responsibility for overall supervision of the recreation programs and activities. The Recreation **[Director] Superintendent** shall direct and supervise all employees assigned to the recreation **[direction]** department and shall have the authority and responsibility for the assignment of employees to all functions within the Department. **The Recreation Superintendent shall control and manage all lands, playgrounds and recreation places within the Borough of Bound Brook.** The Recreation **[Director] Superintendent** shall be under the direction of the Borough Administrator **[and Recreation Commission]**. **The Recreation Superintendent shall also serve as a non-voting member of the Recreation Advisory Board.**

§ 2-23.3 **[Assistant] Recreation Director**.

There shall be **[an] a [Assistant] Recreation Director** appointed by the Mayor and Council. The **[Assistant] Recreation Director [shall be an assistant to the Recreation Director and shall perform such duties of the Recreation Director as may be assigned by the] shall direct and manage all sports leagues as may be approved by** the Borough Administrator, Recreation **[Director] Superintendent, [Recreation Commission], and/or** Mayor or Borough Council, so far as permitted by law.

§ 2-23.4 Assistant Recreation Director.

There shall be an Assistant Recreation Director appointed by the Mayor and Council. The Assistant Recreation Director shall be an assistant to the Recreation Superintendent and Recreation Director, and shall perform such duties of the Assistant Recreation Director as may be assigned by the Borough Administrator, Recreation Superintendent, Recreation Director, and/or Mayor or Borough Council, so far as permitted by law.

SECTION 2: REPEAL OF INCONSISTENT PROVISIONS

All ordinances or parts thereof in conflict or inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed, but only to the extent of such conflict or inconsistency, it being the legislative intent that all such ordinances or part of ordinances now existing or in effect unless the same are in conflict or inconsistent with any provision of this Ordinance shall remain in effect.

SECTION 3: SEVERABILITY

The provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable and if any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase thereof for any reason be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections, subsections, sentences, clauses and phrases of this Ordinance, but shall remaining in effect; it being the legislative intent that this Ordinance shall stand notwithstanding the invalidity of any part.


SECTION 4: EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and publication as provided by law.
