TOWN OF BRANT LOCAL LAW No. 2–2023

A Local Law Amending the Provisions of Chapter 145, Article III, Section 145-4 of the Brant Town Code updating the Senior Citizens Property Tax Exemption

BE IT ENACTED BY THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF BRANT AS FOLLOWS:

1. Section 145-4 of Chapter 145 ("Taxation"), Article III, ("Senior Citizens Exemption") of the Town of Brant Code is hereby amended in its entirety to read as follows:

Section 145-4. Exemption Granted.

Pursuant to Section 467 of the Real Property Tax Law of the State of New York, as amended, the Town Board of the Town of Brant, hereby grants, for town taxation, an exemption of 50% of the assessed valuation of real property being the principal residence owned and occupied by persons 65 years of age or older who qualify therefor under said section, provided that said persons do not have adjusted gross incomes in excess of \$30,000.00 for the income tax years immediately preceding the date of application for said exemption. Pursuant to the local option granted by said Section 467, distributions from individual retirement accounts and individual retirement annuities shall be included when calculating adjusted gross income for purposes of this section.

2. This law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Office of the Secretary of State as provided in Section 27 of the Municipal Home Rule Law.
