**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH OF BRIDGEPORT,  
MONTGOMERY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, APPOINTING**

**CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSIONERS**

**WHEREAS**, The Borough Code Act 37 of 2014, Section 1001, specifies that the Borough shall organize on the first Monday of January of even-numbered years to elect a president and a vice president; and

**WHEREAS**, The Borough Code Act 37 of 2014, Section 1001, specifies that the Borough may appoint other officers as may be provided by law;

**WHEREAS**, The three (3) Civil Service Commissioners are appointed for a staggered six (6) year term and currently the Board is made up of the following appointed Commissioners:

- DeShawn Williams was appointed in 2023 as the Civil Service Commission Alternate, with a term ending 12/31/2023.
- Peter DiSanto's Commissioner term ends on 12/31/2027; however, he submitted his resignation to Borough Council in 2023. Therefore, his position will be filled at this reorganization meeting.
- Michael Hays's term ends 12/31/2023; Therefore, his position will be filled at this reorganization meeting.
- Dennis Orangers is a member of the commission, and his term ends 12/31/25.

**BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Borough Council of the Borough of Bridgeport has duly appointed Michael Hays to a six-year term, ending December 31, 2029.


