

**MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL MEETING OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE
VILLAGE OF BRONXVILLE HELD APRIL 21, 2026 AT 8:30AM
AT VILLAGE HALL, 200 PONDFIELD ROAD, BRONXVILLE, N.Y.**

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At 8:30am on a motion by Deputy Mayor Underhill, seconded by Mayor Marvin the Village Board unanimously agreed to open the special meeting.

Mayor Marvin explained that the first order of business was to close the public hearing on the budget and consider adoption of same. The Village Administrator explained that he had received no further comments, written or otherwise. Mayor Marvin expressed that her feedback was all positive and that the community appreciated the additional outreach and details on the budget through the website, newsletter, Mayor’s Column and Village Board meeting. The Deputy Mayor further thanked the Village Administrator, Treasurer and all the staff involved in the budget for their hard work, thorough analysis and attention to detail in creating the document.

On a motion by Trustee Knapp, seconded by Deputy Mayor Underhill the Village Board unanimously agreed to close the public hearing and further agreed to consider the resolution presented by the Village Administrator for adoption of the Village’s 2026-27 Budget.

On a motion by Trustee Knapp, seconded by Deputy Mayor Underhill the Village Board unanimously agreed to adopt the budget for the 2026-27 fiscal year.

**RESOLUTION
ADOPTING THE 2026-2027 BRONXVILLE BUDGET**

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees has met at the times and place specified in the Notice of Public Hearing on the proposed budget, and heard all persons desiring to be heard thereon; and,

WHEREAS, the budget was reviewed and as hereinafter set forth, is hereby adopted and the salaries and wages stated within the budget are fixed at the amounts shown, effective June 1, 2026, unless otherwise amended by the Board of Trustees or the Village Administrator as provided under NYS Law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Tentative Budget shall constitute the Adopted Budget for the Village of Bronxville for the fiscal year June 1, 2026 to May 31, 2027, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Trustees shall levy a property tax of \$13,372,296 (tax rate 3.5031 per \$1000 assessed valuation) on the applicable real property of the Village of Bronxville, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Trustees shall use \$200,000 from tax stabilization funds for the 2026-2027 budget, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Trustees shall use \$100,000 from assigned fund balance for health insurance expenditures for the 2026-2027 budget, and

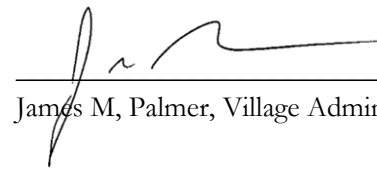
BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Trustees shall use \$75,000 from assigned fund balance for NYS pension fund expenditures for the 2026-2027 budget.

The Village Administrator then took the Village Board through the Stipulation of Agreement executed with Sergeant Cheryl Jarosz.

On a motion by Deputy Mayor Underhill, seconded by Mayor Marvin the Village Board unanimously ratified the stipulation of agreement dated April 15, 2026 accepting the irrevocable letter of resignation for the purposes of retirement of Sergeant Jarosz.

On a motion by Mayor Marvin, seconded by Trustee Knapp the Village Board unanimously agreed to go into an Executive Session to discuss a real estate matter.

At 10:00am on a motion by Deputy Mayor Underhill, seconded by Mayor Marvin the Village Board closed the Executive Session and agreed to adjourn the meeting.
